<u>Direct2Food (www.direct2food.org)</u> is an online resource for people in the metropolitan Chicago area that connects you to the food pantries, soup kitchens, and meal programs closest to you. Direct2Food will also help you determine if you are eligible for further assistance like food stamps and resources for Women, Infants, and Children (WIC).

**SNAP** is the Supplemental Nutrition Assistance program. It used to be called Food Stamps.

Stamps) helps low-income individuals and families purchase the foods they need to stay healthy and are accepted at most grocery stores. Benefits are provided on the Illinois Link Card - an electronic card that is accepted at most grocery stores. Apply for food stamps today through the Department of Human Services online form or through completing this paper application.
