It is that time of the year to start recruiting volunteers for Northcenter Chamber of Commerce's Ribfest Chicago! Ribfest is one of Chicago's best street festivals providing music, beverages, and literally tons of ribs. The fest runs from **Friday**, **June 6th through Sunday**, **June 8th**. The Chamber generously donates grant money to Thresholds Supported Employment Program based on the amount of volunteers that complete a shift at the event. Please feel free to share this with your family and friends as all are welcome to participate.

What can I volunteer to do at Ribfest?

- 1. ID help provide responsible entertainment by checking id's of those who partake in adult beverages.
- 2. Beverage one of the most popular, you will take tickets in exchange for beer, wine, pop, and water. (This goes the quickest, sign up now!)
- 3. Gate Great speakers are needed to help spread the word about the suggested donation as festival goers enter the grounds (donations provide funding for the grants)
- 4. Kids Square Monitor lines for children's rides and activities. (Responsible young adults are also allowed to volunteer for this area)

How do I get involved?

- 1. Print out the attached form and fill in the CONTACT INFORMATION. Please write Thresholds as your organization.
- 2. Select a REQUESTED ASSIGNMENT (Gate, ID, Beverage, or Kids Square) and then pick which day & time (SHIFT INFORMATION) that works best for you.
 - a. Don't forget to select your t-shirt size.
 - b. This year we have 60 spots reserved for the Friday, 4-7:30 shift. First come first serve.
- 3. Sign and date
- 4. Photocopy a state ID or drivers license
- 5. Fax the application and ID to (773) 537-3542, attn: Repsie Royster

- 2. Day of the event you receive a Ribfest T-shirt
- 3. After completion of your shift you receive food and beverage tickets

2014 Ribfest Chicago Volunteer Registration VOLUNTEER RULES AND GUIDELINES

GENERAL

- All Ribfest participants and their employees are expected to serve as a positive representation of the community and at no time should there be any illegal activities taking place at the festival. Any volunteer found in violation of these rules can be immediately removed from the festival and prosecuted at the Chamber's discretion.
- Due to attempted theft at a previous festival, Ribfest
 Chicago has been forced to implement an additional
 security measure. All volunteers must provide a photo
 copy of a valid ID with the Volunteer Registration form.
- This event will be photographed and videotaped. By participating in this event you hereby consent to the use of your likeness or image in those photographs or video for future promotional consideration by Ribfest Chicago, the Northcenter Chamber of Commerce and/or Big Buzz Idea Group.

REQUIRED TRAINING

 All Ribfest volunteers will be required to attend a short volunteer training session prior to the event. Volunteers who attend the training sessions will be given first priority in scheduling. Training Sessions will be held:

Wednesday, May 28, 4 PM and 6:30 PM John C. Coonley School, 4046 N. Leavitt St.

Tuesday, June 3, 6 PM St. Benedict School, Beaven Hall 2215 W. Irving Park Rd.

ON-SITE REQUIREMENTS

- Volunteers must check-in at the Northcenter Chamber office located at 4054 N. Lincoln Ave. for their assignment when they arrive at the festival. T-shirts will be presented by the Northcenter Chamber for the volunteers at the Volunteer sign-in at the start of each shift. Volunteers will be issued one t-shirt. There are no on-site changing facilities. For festival security, the NCC restroom will NOT be available to volunteers.
- Volunteers in the Beer Tents must be 21 or older.
 NO exceptions!
- Upon completion of each shift, volunteers must sign-out at the Chamber office. Food and beverage tickets will be presented to each volunteer at the sign-out of each shift.
- Volunteers are asked to arrive for their shift 15 minutes early for a briefing of their duties, assignment to their post and a smooth transition. Volunteers for the first shifts on Saturday and Sunday are not required to arrive earlier than 11 AM.

- Volunteers will not be allowed to drink alcoholic beverages while on duty.
- Anyone suspected of theft will be immediately removed from their post and, if appropriate, prosecuted to the full extent of the law.

SHIFT DUTIES

- GATE: accept entrance donations, hand out schedule, hand stamps
- ID LINE: wristbands for persons 21 and over
- BEVERAGE: pour and hand out beverages, accept tickets for beverages
- KIDS SQUARE: collect donations, hand out wristbands and goodie bags, assist with inflatables

LIABILITY LIMITATIONS

 NCC, BBIG, employees, related festival providers and participating sponsors shall NOT be responsible for any injury, loss or damage that may occur to the volunteer or property thereof, during this contract. The volunteer signing this contract expressly releases all of the aforementioned from any and all claims from such loss, damage or injury.
