Coming Out Day was conceived in 1988 by Robert Eichberg and Jean O'Leary to respond to anti-LGBT social action.

National Coming Out Day was established to promote positivity and celebrate coming out.

October 11 was chosen to launch National Coming Out Day to coincide with the anniversary of the second National March on Washington for Lesbian and Gay Rights in 1987.

Sharing our authentic selves with others is not always safe or easy. Yet, it can be extraordinarily powerful in breaking down the barriers faced by people who identify as LGBTQ+.
